



SANITARY INSTRUCTION, BIOSAFETY COVID-19

Skorpios Cruises is committed towards the well-being and safety of our passengers, staff and collaborators, we have implemented the following Biosafety Instructions due to the pandemic of the COVID-19. These instructions will be rigorously applied in all Chonos Route cruises during the season in January, February, March and April 2022.



PASSENGER RECEPTION AND BOARDING

- Temperature control of all people entering the Skorpios Maritime Terminal and prior to boarding.
- Mandatory use of face masks.
- Passenger boarding will be divided into several groups, scheduled as the following. Friday: between 18:00 hrs. and 22:00 hrs. Saturday: between 07:00 hrs. and 12:00 hrs. Embark time frames of each group will be indicated by sales executives.
- Documents to present at the check in:
Valid Mobility Pass, PCR test (the test must date back no more than 72 hours from the time the sample was taken), mandatory Antigen Test, Health Declaration and Disembarkation Authorization.
- Antigen Test cost: USD 13 per person.
- Sanitizing suitcases and luggage at the time of check-in at the clean point of the Skorpios Terminal. Boarding by the covered area of the ship.
- Mandatory use of a footbath while entering the ship.
- Mask and alcohol gel dispensers on board.
- Each passenger will be handed the COVID Kit (masks, bandanna and alcohol gel).





BIOSAFETY ON BOARD DURING NAVIGATION

- Safety and Biosafety talk on deck scheduled for two groups of passengers, 45 passengers in each group.
- Informing passengers regarding Biosafety Instructions before the cruise begins, via CCTV.
- Maintaining distance.
- Cabin cleaning and disinfecting: once a day.
- Cleaning of common areas: permanent sanitizing of tables, chairs, surfaces at the bars, dining room and frequent contact points.
- Air extraction in each cabin.
- Temperature daily self-control of all the passengers. Twice a day, during breakfast and dinner.
- Mask and alcohol gel dispensers, footbaths in common areas.
- Doctor on board for the exclusive care of passengers, with a kit of medicines for common diseases and COVID medicines.



DINING ROOM & BARS

DINING ROOM

- Mask and alcohol gel dispensers at the entrance and temperature self-control.
- 2 meters distance between table edges.
- Assignment of tables according to the capacity in the Dining Room and Zeus Room.
- Menu will be placed on an intranet platform (QR code) or led monitor.
- Attention of a waiter will be assigned to each table.
- Sanitized food and tableware.
- Disposable paper tablecloths and napkins.
- Food will be handled according to the sanitary protocol.

APOLO BAR

- Restricted capacity according to the capacity to maintain the distance.
- Time of stay will be restricted.



COMMON AREAS

- *Face masks are mandatory during the stay on the ship and excursions.*



ACTIVITIES & EXCURSIONS

EXCURSIONS

- *Passengers will be divided into groups during landing, sixteen people in each group.*
- *During the visit to the San Rafael Glacier, there will be special boats with restricted boarding capacity. The excursion will be done in two turns.*
- *Passengers will be divided into groups in transit areas and boat seats.*
- *Separation of circuits to be covered.*
- *Temperature self-control at entry and exit.*
- *It is forbidden to consume food in towns and cities visited.*
- *Passengers have to carry their masks and alcohol gel dispensers.*
- *Mandatory use of footbaths while entering and leaving the ship.*



CREW ON BOARD

- *Mandatory use of personnel masks.*
- *Permanent handwashing.*
- *Biosafety, hygiene and sanitation standards training of the personnel.*





TO KEEP IN MIND

Due to capacity issues and COVID protocols, there are the following modifications of our traditional cruises:

- *Thermal baths in Quintralco: their use will depend on the authorization and regulations of the Ministry of Health of Chile.*
- *The Captain's Buffet Dinner and Dance are suspended due to reasons of distancing.*
- *Meal times:*
 - *Breakfast: 07:00 - 09:00 hrs.*
 - *Lunch: 13:00 - 14:30 hrs.*
 - *Dinner: 20:00 - 21:30 hrs.*
- *The breakfast buffet will be served at the table.*
- *There is no courtesy parking at the Skorpios Maritime Terminal, there is an agreement with Auto Parking Tepual which has an additional cost.*
